MINUTES OF COMMITTEE MEETING

2 The minutes of the meeting on 10 October 2014 were accepted.

It was agreed that the meeting in Peterborough on 1 November 2014 had been a success, though with better advertising there might have been greater attendance.

3 Peter Landshoff drew attention to the new [Plain English Guide to the Planning System](#) published by DCLG.

He reported on the HLF regional stakeholders meeting on 20 November, and mentioned HLF's priority areas in the region: Castle Point, Hertfordshire (Broxbourne, Three Rivers and Watford), Luton, Fens, and Thurrock.

He also drew attention to the [evaluation](#) of the 2014 Heritage Counts report being conducted by English Heritage.

4 It was agreed that Peter Lee should succeed Peter Landshoff as chair of EECAS. The meeting in Norwich on 7 February would be invited to endorse this, or make other proposals. The operation of EECAS would be reviewed at the next meeting of the Committee.

5 The draft programme for the meeting in Norwich on 7 February being organised by Civic Voice was noted. Concern was expressed that so far it had not been advertised, though CambridgePPF was emailing the 383 subscribers to the EECAS newsletter.
