## Waymarked Walks



### Rowan's Walk

1.6 miles, 50 minutes. Grass track. Easy walk.



### Bin Brook Walk

0.9 miles, 30 minutes. Grass track. Easy walk.



### View Point Walk

1.8 miles, 1 hour. Grass track. Some slopes/steps.



### Spine Route Walk

1.5 miles, 50 minutes. Concrete surfaced route suitable for cyclists, wheelchairs & pushchairs. Follow the track there and back.
